

## NOTICE OF TAX ABATEMENT AMENDMENT CONSIDERATION

NOTICE is hereby given that the Sabine-Neches Navigation District will consider amending a Tax Abatement Agreement with Emerald Renewable Diesel, LLC ("Emerald") at its Regular Meeting of the Board of Commissioners on Tuesday, February 8, 2022, at 3:30 p.m., at its office at 8180 Anchor Drive, Port Arthur, Texas 77642.

Emerald is proposing to construct improvements on land to be leased from Golden Triangle Properties LLC at the GT OmniPort site, which improvements will be used to produce renewable diesel fuel (the "Project"). Emerald has proposed to construct the Project on property located within the GT Logistics Reinvestment Zone, 1998 H O Mills Blvd, Port Arthur, TX 77640. The estimated cost of the proposed Project is more than \$330 million. The proposed Project will include the construction of a new renewable diesel refinery and necessary associated facilities. The Project will be located near feedstock processing and finished product shipping facilities owned and being constructed by others.
